Translating our Newsletter

This year in collaboration with our Community Hub, we are trialling a new system to translate our newsletter into different languages. We are beginning with Mrs Yacoub recording herself reading the newsletter in Arabic. To access this recording, you need to download a QR Code reader onto your Smartphone then scan the code. Please see instructions below for further details. This will open a link where you can then listen to the recording in another language. Once we have managed this for Arabic, we are looking at extending this to other languages.

How to scan QR Codes with smartphones

Apple's iPhones have built-in QR code scanning capabilities, so there's no need to download a separate scanning app unless you really want to. Ever since iOS 12, there's even a direct QR code reader in the Control Panel.

Android Phones

Download QR Code Reader from Google Play Launch QR Code Reader Allow the app permission to take pictures and record video Point the phone's camera at the QR code so it sits inside the square shown on screen The app will read the QR code and offer up a link to the related website




