Weekly Message

Dear Parents,

It has been another very busy week at our school as we move towards the end of Term 2 and our half yearly break. Some important activities this week are:

Stage 2 Excursion

On Wednesday Stage 2 students travelled to Minnamurra Rainforest as part of their Mappen Unit on Sustainability. As you will appreciate if you have visited Minnamurra, the rainforest walk is an amazing experience and students were able to observe and experience the interaction between all the various plants and creatures first hand. Honour at Choral Festival

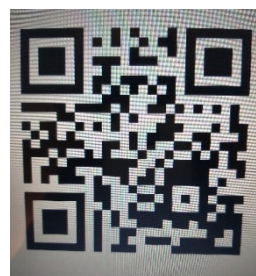

We are excited to launch our partnership with a **Paper Planes event on Friday 28th June, 2pm-3pm**. An invitation will come home with your child today.

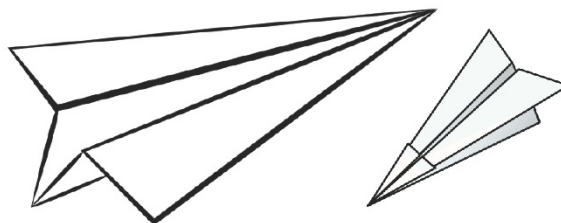
