Dear Parents,

It has been another very busy week at our school with students engaged in a range of activities. Of note this week:

Lockdown/Evacuation Drills

Over the last few weeks, your children may have come home telling you that we have had a "Lockdown" or as it was yesterday, an Evacuation. As part of our Work Health and Safety obligations, we are required to have several drills during each year to ensure that we would respond quickly and effectively if such an event was to occur. We have had several practice drills over the last few weeks and I am pleased to report that the refinements that we have made after each drill have meant that we are now confident that our procedures are now appropriate should they need to be enacted.

Information Evening/P&C Meeting

Last Tuesday evening at we modified our usual P&C meeting and adopted a new format which aims to provide information to parents in an informal and relaxed setting. It also provides an opportunity for you to give feedback or ask questions about aspects of school operation that you may find puzzling.

I believe it was a success as we had a great discussion around several topics relating to the school and its future development growth. We talked about our new building, possible class formations for 2019 and Visible Learning. I found it particularly useful, as it provided me with feedback in several areas that will help us in responding to your and your children's needs.

Stage 3 Cyber Safety

As part of National Child Protection Week, Stage 3 students participated in the Cyberbullying and Blackmail Adobe connect session this week. This involved listening to a presenter online who went through several different scenarios with students reflecting on the choices they would make. We got to share our ideas and discuss various situations that children may encounter. There were many schools from all over the state involved and this was a great experience to help develop our children's awareness around their responsibilities when online.

Community Hub Computer Skills

Yesterday (Thursday) was the first session in our Community Hub Computer skills course. It was a very busy morning with 15 mothers engaged in developing their skills in technology. Ms Yacoub and Mr Richards tell me that everyone got a lot out of it and all participants are looking forward to continuing their learning next Thursday

Today our top athletes are in Canberra participating in the Regional Athletics Carnival. I'm sure you will all join me in wishing them all the best as they compete in their various events.

Building Program

I have just been talking to Gary Petersen, the General Foreman from building company HansenYuncken, and he tells me that next Tuesday will see the first lot of safety fencing erected around the old toilet block near our playing fields in preparation for its refurbishment. I will be holding weekly meetings with the building team so will keep you informed as work progresses.
