Dear Parents,

Welcome back everyone to Term 4 of 2018. It seems no time at all since we were welcoming everyone to a new school year and now it is almost over. There has already been a lot of activity at our school this week and notable events include:

Stage 3 Science Fair

Yesterday (Thursday) saw the culmination of weeks of work by Stage 3 students in the Science Fair, where all the reports about the many science experiments conducted were displayed on the top floor of A Block. The standard of work was astounding, with students tackling some very challenging topics, and displaying a very good understanding of their subject in both their report, and also in the conversations that I had with many of them. Some of the projects are displayed in this newsletter, and there will also be some added to the school website. The projects voted best by students staff and parents will be entered into the University of Wollongong competition where they will compete with schools from around the region. Congratulations to all Stage 3 students on such high quality research, and thank you to the Stage 3 teachers for organising the activity.

Building Program – New and Refurbished Toilets; Admin Refurbishment; Teaching Building

The two new demountable toilet blocks that were installed behind the canteen are almost ready for use. On Tuesday morning I joined a team from the Department of Education and the supervising Project Management team to check for minor defects before they will be opened for student use probably late next week.

Work has also continued on the refurbishment of the Bottom Grass toilet block, with the entire building now gutted and preparation work happening for the installation of new doors windows and plumbing.

On Tuesday morning the Project Reference Group met and discussed aspects of the administration and teaching spaces, focusing mainly on the joinery – walls, storage facilities window placements and while it was initially proposed that we would be signing off on Admin, Learning Centre and Landscaping areas, the reality was that we only covered the Admin and Toilet refurb aspects of the program.

Chess

This morning the Wollongong Public A chess team hosted Tudor House in the South Coast Region Final. The four players, each had to play their opponents twice, once as white and once as black. After a hard fought contest Wollongong were victorious by 8 games to 0.

Congratulations to our team who are now South Coast Region Chess Champions!

Debating

Yesterday our debating team went to Figtree Heights Public School for the quarter final round of the Premier's Debating Challenge.. The topic of the debate was 'Spelling Bees Should Be Banned In All Schools,' and we were defending the affirmative position. Unfortunately, our team was not successful, although we received very positive feedback from teachers, parents from the other school and the adjudicator. Mrs Beckinsale, who accompanied the team reports that our team were wonderful ambassadors for our school, and I'm sure you will join me in saying how proud we are of their efforts.

Stage 3 Interrelate

As Stage 3 parents are aware, as part of PDHPE (Personal Development, Health and Physical Education) each year we engage an external advisor to teach part of the personal development section of the curriculum. This year the Interrelate company is our provider, and they are teaching appropriate lessons based on the NSW Curriculum about the changes that occur in children's bodies as they get older, and also around keeping themselves safe. Year 5 sessions have already commenced, and Year 6 will commence later in the term. These are very important lessons, and I would urge you to support your children in attending these sessions.
