### Wollongong Illawarra Coal Science Fair


Battling the 25 degree heat, which was contrasting the downpour of rain outside the University of Wollongong's Sports Hub, 12 students from Wollongong Public School contested in Australia's largest science fair. The dull weather outside didn't have an impact on the students' mood (thankfully) as they competed at a high level with hopeful and motivated spirits.

The University of Wollongong Illawarra Coal Science Fair was held on the 28th of November to celebrate the love of science which was common and resonating throughout the sports hub on the day. 950 contestants were expected to attend the event, all hoping to impress judges with their knowledge of their subject, which ranged in the areas of STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths). Roughly 80 schools were present, being judged for their overall results.

Wollongong Public School was proud to receive a prestigious Leadership Award (**the** grand prize, you could call it), which symbolised the students' consistency in achieving high results. Along with our group's overall achievement, Ronan received a 2nd place out of all the contestants in Stage 2 and Shiv received a 3rd place out of all the contestants in Stage 3. All students were proud of representing our school in such a great manner.


